

Cooperation with Latin America

IM-AGIMB has been giving an important contribution to the expansion of the Brazilian scientific collaboration with mathematicians from several countries in Latin America: Argentina, Bolivia, Chile, Colombia, México, Peru, Uruguay e Venezuela. As planned in the original project of IM-AGIMB, two kinds of actions have been conceived and are taking place to consolidate and up-grade substantially the cooperation of Brazilian mathematics with Latin America:

- Tutorial missions at an introductory level, directed to young undergraduate students of the neighboring countries and advanced level tutorial missions, directed to advance undergraduate and graduate students, as well as researchers.
- Visits of Latin American researchers to Brazil to collaborate with local mathematicians in research projects and to participate in congresses, workshops and in Brazilian Post-Doctoral programs.

As a consequence, the number of joint research work, visits and missions has increased substantially contributing to a general research environment in mathematics in the region.
